DECLINE IN SALE OF AUTOMOBILE SECTOR

285. SHRI THIRUNAVUKKARASAR SU:

- (a) whether the retail sale of two-wheelers and four wheelers have reduced considerably in the last few months;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during the last three quarters, quarter-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to improve the sale of automobile sector in the coming years and to provide sops to the sector particularly for the 2-wheeler sector;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b): Quarter wise details of sales from OEMs(Original Equipment Manufacturers) to dealerships, during the last three quarters, as per the report of Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM) is as under:

Passenger Vehicle	7,84,734	6,55,590	1,53,734
Commercial Vehicles	1,95,222	1,46,986	31,636
Two-wheelers	42,18,241	35,02,642	12,93,113
