- (a) the number of institutes, organizations under the Ministry that are in existence for monitoring and tending domesticated animals in India;
- (b) whether the Ministry has undertaken any review of these institutions recently and whether any of these have been scheduled to close, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of budgetary allocation for these institutions thereto?

- (a) The institutions or organisations in existence under the Ministry for development of livestock including poultry are given below along with their numbers.
 - 1. Central Poultry Development Organizations (4 Nos.),
 - 2. Central Poultry Performance Training Centre (1 No.),
 - 3. Central Sheep Breeding Farm (1 No.),
 - 4. Regional Fodder Stations(5 Nos.).
 - **5. Central Cattle Breeding Farms (7 Nos.)**
 - 6. Central Herd Registration Scheme (4 units).
 - 7. Chaudhary Charan Singh National Institute of Animal Health (CCSNIAH)
- (b) The Government is undertaking a periodical review of all the institutions under the Department and there is no proposal to close any institutes.
- (c) As per Budget Estimates for the year 2020-21, a total of Rs.101.27 Crores have been allocated for the above institutions/organisations.
