(a): The Details of the quantum of foodgrains production during crop year 2019-20 in the country along with their procurement at Minimum Support Price (MSP) by Government Agencies is as under:

(b): As on 31.07.2020, the total available storage capacity with Food Corporation of India (FCI) and State agencies for storage of foodgrains meant for PDS/NFSA throughout the country is 781.22 Lakh MT (FCI – 416.52 LMT and State Agencies – 364.70 LMT). The State-wise details of available storage capacity are at Annexure-I.

In addition to the above capacity, approx. 111.61 LMT capacity is also being used by State Government for storage of commodities other than Wheat & Rice and also for intermediary storage for PDS stocks.

(c) and (d): Adequate storage capacity is available with FCI for the safe storage and management of procured food grains. The storage capacity with FCI and the stock held during the last three years & the current year (as on 30th June) is as under:-
