Revival of Sick Units

- (a) whether the Government is planning to revive the sick units of urea plants during the coming years' as part of its Aatmanirbhar Bharat initiative;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has received any request from fertilizer industry to review the urea subsidy system to make existing factories viable and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the response of the Government on such request?

However, in the public sector, Madras Fertilizers Limited (MFL) the only urea producing sick Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSE) which is operational, has undertaken enhancement of its operating efficiencies through asset monetization and manpower rationalization.
