Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has developed any indicators for the compliance with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has issued any guidelines to record information on the indicators for the SDGs and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government has set up any committee(s) to study the compliance with the SDGs or with specific goals?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): The Ministry has developed a National Indicator Franework (NIF) for nonitoring the progress of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). At present, there are 302 national indicators in the NIF. The Ministry has also designed metadata format and guidelines for source Ministries to report data on SDGs indicators. The Ministry has released the progress report on SDGs-NIF, namely "Sustainable Development Goals National Indicator Franework Progress Report, 2020 (version 2.1)" on 29th June, 2020, with time series data.

(c): The Ministry has developed a dashboard for SDGs to show progress on the indicators. NITI Aayog has also constituted a Task Force on implementation of SDGs and developed an SDG India Index to show state-wise position and progress on SDGs.
