- (c) the plans of Railways to utilize its large land bank for commercial purposes instead of adding more burden on passengers like user fee, etc?

(a) to (c): A Group of Secretaries (GoS) was constituted for redevelopment and modernisation of railway stations to provide better safety, passenger amenities and services. The GoS interalia suggested the levy of a nominal user fee for redevelopment of stations, which is presently under consideration.
