PENDING RAILWAY PROJECTS

†530. SHRI DHARAMBIR SINGH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of other projects including Loharu to Bhiwani and Delhi to Alwar via Nuh-Firozpur Jhirka rail lines in Haryana have been pending for a long time due to paucity of funds and other technical reasons;**
- (b) if so, the project-wise details thereof for the last three years;**
- (c) whether the Government has not allocated sufficient funds for these pending railway projects; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?**

(a) to (d) : No Sir. However, these two Railway Projects have not yet been sanctioned. Present status of these Projects is as under :-

Loharu to Bhiwani Rail Line

The Feasibility Study for the work of Loharu to Bhiwani was done by Railway. Thereafter on the directions of Government of

Haryana, the Feasibility Study has again been conducted by Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (HRIDC) a Joint Venture between Ministry of Railways (49%) and Government of Haryana (51%). The Survey Report was submitted to Government of Haryana on 30.04.2019. Further action on the project will be taken after receiving the proposal from HRIDC.

Delhi to Alwar via Nuh-Firozpur Jhirka Rail Line.

The Feasibility Study for this was done by Railway. Thereafter on the directions of Government of Haryana, the Feasibility Study has again been conducted by Haryana Rail Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (HRIDC) a Joint Venture between Ministry of Railways (49%) and Government of Haryana (51%). The Survey Report was submitted to Government of Haryana on 30.04.2019. Further action on the project will be taken after receiving the proposal from HRIDC.
