(a) There are 29.83 rural internet subscribers per 100 population in the country as on 31st December 2019 as per latest "The Indian Telecom Services Performance Indicators" report of Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) dated 30th June 2020. The License Service Area-wise details are at Annexure.

(b) Yes, Sir.

(c) BharatNet project implemented in a phased manner to provide broadband/internet connectivity to all the Gram Panchayats (GPs) in the country, includes Odisha. A total of 1,43,885 GPs is made Service Ready as on 04.09.2020, including 4522 in Odisha.

(d) Question does not arise.
