(a) to (b) No, Telecom Service Providers in the country are using diverse cellular mobile technologies viz. 2G, 3G, 4G and their combinations to provide voice & data services.

The Choice of technology for provision of telecom services are left to the Service Provider as per their respective business considerations. The Department of Telecommunications, Government of India makes available sufficient spectrum through auction for mobile services across different bands.
