DOUBLING OF RAILWAY TRACKS

650. SHRI MOHANBHAI KALYANJI KUNDARIYA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) the present status of railway track doubling of (i) Surendranagar-Daladi section and (ii) Daladi-Rajkot section;

(b) whether the sections of this project are progressing as per the schedule, if not, the reasons thereof; and

(c) by when the railway track doubling of both the sections are targeted to be completed?

ANSWER

(SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a): Surendranagar-Daladi-Rajkot doubling project was included in the Budget 2015-16. Latest anticipated cost of the project is ₹1002 crore and expenditure of ₹501 crore has been incurred upto March, 2020. An outlay of ₹205 crore has been provided for this project for the year 2020-21. The present status of the project is as under:

(i) Surendranagar-Daladi section: Land acquisition is completed except in village Muli. Works have been taken up wherever land is available. Work in Surendranagar-Disgar section (about 14 Km length) has been completed.

(ii) Daladi-Rajkot section: Land acquisition is completed except between Khorana to Rajkot. Works have been taken up wherever land is available.

(b) & (c): Completion of project would depend upon land acquisition in the remaining section. Therefore, confirmed timeline for completion of the project is not feasible to be fixed.
