(a) to (c) Occurrence and filling up of vacancies is a continuous process and the same is filled by placement of indents by Railways with recruitment agencies as per operational requirements. During this process, vacancies may arise and these are filled subsequently. From 2014-2015 to 2018-2019, total number of 2,74,075 Group 'C' (including Level-1) employees have retired and 1,84,262 candidates have been empanelled for various Group 'C' posts (including Level-1). The Groupwise (Group 'C' & Level-1) and year-wise details for retirement and empanelment are as under-

(d) The number of sanctioned posts (Group 'C' and level 1) lying vacant as on 01.04.2020 (Provisional) is 2,90,965.
