**Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of sports funding through National Sports Federations (NSFs);**
- (b) whether any budget has been prepared for increasing allocation to develop sports infrastructure in the country; and**
- (c) if so, the details thereof?**

- (a) Under the Scheme of Assistance to National Sports Federations (NSFs), funds are provided for conduct of national championships, international tournaments in India, participation in international tournaments abroad, coaching camps, purchase**

**of equipments, engagement of foreign coaches, etc. Budgetary allocation for Scheme of Assistance to NSFs during 2019-20 was Rs. 300.85 crore and budgetary allocation during current financial year 2020-21 is Rs. 245.00 crore.**

**(b) &(c) An amount of Rs.390.42 crore has been allocated for creation of capital assets i.e. for utilization and creation/upgradation of sports infrastructure in this Financial Year 2020-21 as compared 295.87 crore spent on the same during last Financial Year 2019-20.**
