Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the districts included under Atal Jyoti Yojana, State-wise;
- (b) the quantum of funds spent in each district during the last three years under the said yojana, districtwise;
- (c) whether solar lights can be installed in Bhiwani, Mahendragarh and Dadri districts of Haryana under the said scheme;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the budget allocated for the said purpose; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) Phase-I of Atal Jyoti Yojana (AJAY) Scheme, launched in September 2016, covered all districts of the states of Assam, Bihar, Jharkhand, Odisha and Uttar Pradesh.

Under Phase-II of AJAY Scheme, launched in December 2018, coverage was expanded to include:

- i. All districts of five states covered under Phase-I
- ii. All districts of hilly states/UTs i.e. Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh and Uttarakhand
- iii. All districts of North Eastern states including Sikkim
- iv. All districts of Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep
- v. Balance 48 aspirational districts other than those covered in (i) to (iv) above.

(b) District-wise details of funds spent in AJAY Phase-I since its launch in September 2016 are placed at **Annexure-I** and district-wise details of funds spent in AJAY Phase-II since its launch in December 2018 are placed at **Annexure-II**.

(c) to (e) Bhiwani, Mahendragarh and Dadri districts of Haryana are not covered under the AJAY scheme as only aspirational districts of Haryana state are covered under the scheme.
