- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any proposal from the Government side to provide reservations to Anglo-Indian community in both educational institutions and employment sector;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) whether the Government has made any efforts for the welfare of Anglo-Indian community by supporting them financially and if so, the details thereof?
