LABOURERS DEPENDENT ON AGRICULTURE

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has made any assessment of labourers dependent on agriculture in the country and if so, the details thereof including Rajasthan;
- (b)whether it has been ascertained that labourers dependent on agriculture get employment throughout the year and if so, the State/UT-wise details including Dausa thereof;
- (c)whether any action has been taken by the Government to provide employment throughout the year to farmers and labourers dependent on agriculture; and
- (d)if so, the details thereof including achievements?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) to (d): Yes, Sir. Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), 2005 provide for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work. Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is a demand driven wage employment

programme. It provides livelihood security i.e., fall back option for livelihood for the rural households when no better employment opportunity is available. The demand for work is influenced by various factors such as rain-fall, availability of alternative and remunerative employment opportunities outside Mahatma Gandhi NREGS. Employment generation coupled with improving employability through skill development is the priority of the Government. Government has taken various steps for generating employment in the country like encouraging private sector of economy, fast-tracking various projects involving substantial investment and increasing public expenditure on schemes like Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS), Pt. Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalyal Yojana (DDU-GKY) and Deendyal Antodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM). Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Protsahan Yojana (PMRPY) has been launched by the Ministry of Labour and Employment for incentivising employers for promoting employment generation. Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) has been initiated by Government inter alia for facilitating selfemployment. Under PMMY collateral free loans upto Rs. 10 lakh, are extended to small/micro business enterprises and to individuals to enable them to setup or expand their business activities.
