### LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 892 TO BE ANSWERED ON 17.09.2020

#### FHTC IN MAHARASHTRA

#### 892. SHRI SUDHAKAR TUKARAM SHRANGARE:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of rural households provided with Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTC) out of total households in Maharashtra especially in drought prone area of Latur district as on date; and
- (b) the time-bound steps taken by the Government to provide FHTCs in all the rural households by December 2022 under Jal Jeevan Mission?

## ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

- (a) As reported by the State, after revalidation of baseline data, as on 14.09.2020, about 45.22% (64.37 lakh) rural households have tap water connection in Maharashtra whereasin Latur district, about 57.18% (2.17 lakh) rural households have tap water connection.
- (b) To enable every rural household in the country to have potable water through Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) by 2024, Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM)-Har Ghar Jal in partnership with States. Further, to complete the work in a time-bound manner, following action has been taken:
  - i.) Every State/ UT has been advised to prepare 'State Action Plan', including year-wise plan for providing tap water connections;
  - ii.) Govt. of India holds regular review meetings with all States & UTs for expediting the implementation including joint review by Union Minister with Chief Ministers of States;
  - iii.) Central financial assistance, to all eligible States/ UTs, is being provided as per the operational guidelines for the implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission;
  - iv.) In consonance with 73rd Amendment of Constitution of India and to instill the sense of ownership among villagers, Gram Panchayat or its sub-committee/ user group i.e. Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC), Paani Samiti, etc. are to plan, implement, manage, operate and maintain in-village water supply system. Thus, Jal Jeevan Mission is a demand-driven, decentralized, community-managed programme.
