**(a): The total number of international flights to and from Jaipur Airport in the last two years to various countries are as follows:**

<b>Year</b>	<b>International Flights (in nos.)</b>
<b>2019-20</b>	<b>3612</b>
<b>2018-19</b>	<b>4166</b>

**(b): Airlines are free to select whatever markets and network they wish to service and operate within the ambit of bilateral agreements. It is, therefore, upon the airlines to provide air services to specific places depending upon the traffic demand and commercial viability.**

**Indian carriers are free to operate services from any point in India including Jaipur to international destinations available under respective bilateral arrangements. Moreover, Jaipur is already included in the list of 18 destinations where the designated Indian carriers as well as designated carriers of SAARC countries (except Afghanistan and Pakistan) and ASEAN countries (Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Brunei, Vietnam, Indonesia, Myanmar, Cambodia, Philippines and Laos) can operate unlimited**
