926. SHRI KANUMURU RAGHU RAMA KRISHNA RAJU:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the reveiw meetings held with the Chief Ministers of the States to take stock of the COVID-19 situation in the country;

(b) the views exchanged by the Chief Ministers to combat the corona virus in the country; and

(c) whether the Government is planning to provide more funds to the States/UTs as suggested by the Chief Ministers; and

(d) if so, the details thereof along with the action proposed to be taken in this regard?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a): 8 meetings were held with Chief Ministers to review COVID-19 situation in their respective States.

(b): The discussions focused on the efforts done by the State to contain the COVID-19, the requirement of augmenting testing facilities, creation of infrastructure, requirement of PPE, Ventilators etc, fund requirement and best practices being followed in their respective States.

(c) & (d): Ministry of Health and Family Welfare through National Health Mission has disbursed funds to the States (details are at **Annexure**).

AtmaNirbhar Bharat underlines the commitment of the Government for increased investments in Public Health and other health reforms to prepare India for future pandemics. An Expenditure Finance Committee proposal has been prepared for more than Rs. 65,000 Crores.

The major components of this proposal are (i) COVID-19 emergency response, (ii) Strengthening of Public Health Infrastructure for pandemic preparedness by including disease surveillance and outbreak response, (iii) Strengthening Disaster and Epidemic Preparedness, (iv) Establishment of dedicated infectious disease management hospital blocks in district hospitals, (iv) Strengthening/Establishment of Integrated Public Health Laboratories, (v) Strengthening/Establishment of Ayushman Bharat Health and Wellness centres etc.
