MODERN FACILITIES IN HOSPITALS

**967. SHRI MALOOK NAGAR:
SHRI ANIL FIROJIYA:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Government hospitals so far in the country where ICU facilities are available;
- (b) the details of the steps being taken by the Government to set up new hospitals and provide modern health facilities in existing hospitals including arrangement of ICU in the country to deal with the situation arising from Covid-19 pandemic;
- (c) whether the Government is providing any financial assistance to hospitals or patients for treatment of novel Corona virus and if so, the details of the criteria fixed in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government is considering to increase health budget in the next financial year; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?

**ANSWER

(a): The number of Government Hospitals, both Central and State Government where ICU facilities are available is not maintained centrally. However, as far as Covid-19 is concerned, the information provided by States on Covid-19 portal gives details of ICU beds and ventilators in COVID dedicated facilities (Government and Private both) and is provided at Annexure .

(b): Public Health and Hospitals being a State subject, the primary responsibility of strengthening of healthcar system including setting up / upgradation of health facilities lies with respective State Government. However, States / UTs are being provided required technical and Financial assistance for managing the COVID 19 Public Health Challenge from time to time

All the States/UTs are provided with necessary financial support under “India COVID 19 Emergency Response and Health System Preparedness Package.” During FY 2020-21 funds of Rs. 4256.81 cr have been released to States / UTs as on 10.9.2020. States may utilise these funds also for setting up of new COVID dedicated facilities.

(c): For treatment of those affected by COVID, Government is implementing Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) to provide health cover of Rs. 5 lakh per family per year for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization to around 10.74 crore poor and vulnerable families (approx. 50 crore Individuals) as per Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC) data. To effectively cover AB-PMJAY beneficiaries for testing and treatment of COVID-19, packages for ‘Testing for COVID-19’ and ‘Treatment of COVID-19’ have been notified.

(d) & (e): The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare will request allocation of funds as per requirements under the overall budget of Government of India.
