IMPLEMENTATION OF NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION IN TAMIL NADU

- (a) whether his Ministry has received Programme Implementation Plan from Tamil Nadu State under National Health Mission;
- (b) if so, details thereof;
- (c) whether the State Government of Tamil Nadu State has reported any shortfall of facilities pertaining to Primary Health Centre; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and corrective steps taken in this regard?

(a) & (b): For the FY 2020-21, the Tamil Nadu Government has submitted the Program Implementation Plan (PIP) of Rs. 3331.23 Crore and administrative approval in the form of Record of Proceedings (RoP) for an amount of Rs. 3107.12 Crore has been issued.

(c) & (d): As per Rural Health Statistics (RHS) 2019, there is no shortfall pertaining to Primary Health Centre. Against the requirement of 1222 PHCs, 1422 PHCs are in position in the State of Tamil Nadu.
