INCLUSION OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE UNDER MSP

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE **कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री**

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government intends to include more agricultural produce in the list for providing Minimum Support Price (MSP) and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has received any representation from the State of Kerala for inclusion of Pepper and Raw Coconut in the list of agricultural produce for providing MSP and if so, the status thereof; and
- (c) the details of agricultural produce procured under MSP from FY 2018-19 to FY 2020-21 till 31st January 2021, State-wise?

(a) to (c): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 204 DUE FOR REPLY ON 9TH MARCH, 2021.

(a): At present, there are twenty two (22) mandated agricultural crops for which the Government of India (GoI) fixes Minimum Support Price (MSP) for every marketing season. These crops are paddy, jowar, bajra, maize, ragi, arhar, moong, urad, groundnut, soybean, sunflower, sesamum, nigerseed, cotton, wheat, barley, gram, masur (lentil), rapeseed/mustard, safflower, jute and copra. Fair & Remunerative Price for sugarcane is also fixed. In addition, MSP for toria and de-husked coconut are also fixed on the basis of MSP of rapeseed/mustard and copra, respectively. These prices are fixed on the basis of the recommendations of the Commission for Agricultural Costs & Prices (CACP), views of State Governments and Central Ministries/ Departments concerned and other relevant factors.

GoI receives various proposals from time to time to include more and more agricultural produce in the list of crops for providing MSP. Since 2018-19, MSP is fixed at minimum of 50 percent over and above the all- India weighted average projected cost of production of crops.

(b): No representation has been received from the State Government of Kerala for inclusion of pepper and raw coconut under MSP.

MSP for Milling Copra and Ball Copra is announced for every crop season. On the basis of MSP of Copra, MSP of de-husked coconut is fixed. Details are given in **Annexure I**.

(c): Statement showing State-wise details of agriculture produce procured under MSP from 2018-19 to 2020-21 (31.01.2021) are annexed at **Annexures from II to VIII**.
