(a): The number of applications received during FY 2018-19 and 2019-20 for setting up food processing industries/ units/ projects in the state of Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh under different component schemes of Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY) is placed at **Annexure -I**.

(b): The details of projects approved under PMKSY during FY 2018-19 and 2019-20 in the state of Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan is placed at **Annexure II** and **Annexure III** respectively.

(c): The component schemes of PMKSY are demand driven and therefore, state wise budget is not allocated under these schemes. However, the amount of grants-in-aid released for the projects in Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh during the 2018-19 and 2019-20 is placed at **Annexure IV**.

(d): Financial assistance provided in the form of Grant-in-Aid for setting up of food processing industries varies under the different components of the scheme. The details are placed at **Annexure V**.
