(a) & (b): Department of Public Enterprises (DPE), being a general policy making Department for CPSEs, has issued on 29th October, 2015 guidelines for "Streamlining the mechanism for revival and restructuring of sick/ incipient sick and weak Central Public Sector Enterprises: General principles and mechanism of restructuring". Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) function under the administrative control of concerned Ministries/Departments and all matters relating to revival/ restructuring of CPSEs are dealt by the concerned administrative Ministry/ Department on a case-to-case basis.

In terms of these guidelines, the administrative ministries/ departments monitor the health of CPSEs and identify the sick/weak/incipient sick CPSEs as per the criteria laid down therein based on their performance and take redressal measures. The criteria laid down in the guidelines facilitate pre-emptive corrective actions to check onset of sickness and take timely appropriate steps to put the CPSEs back to good financial health. The concerned administrative Ministries/ Departments are also responsible to formulate revival/restructuring/closure plans for such CPSEs based on the principles outlined therein on a case-to-case basis in consultation with stakeholders and after obtaining the approval of the competent authority and implement the plan.
