- (e) if not, the future of the said infrastructure/ facilities?

The decline in the number of landline connections is, inter-alia, due to the users finding mobile services to be more convenient with regards to its utility, mobility and availability at all times.
- (c) to (e) The service providers are progressively making use of the existing landline infrastructure for providing Broadband services in the country.
