(a) There are 50 numbers of National Highways covering a length of 6858 km. and 235 numbers of State Highways covering a length of 11175 km. in the State of Tamil Nadu.

(b) State Roads covering a length of 1940 km have been declared as National Highways during last three years and current year in the State of Tamil Nadu.

(c) This Ministry allocates funds State-wise for Development and Maintenance of National Highways in the Country. Expenditure incurred for Development and Maintenance of NHs in the State of Tamil Nadu during last three years & current year is Rs. 8395 Crore.
