LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 50 TO BE ANSWERED ON 04.02.2021 REGARDING HAJJ EMBARKATION POINT FACILITIES TABLED BY SHRI BENNY BEHANAN, MP.

- (a) and (b): In view of Covid-19 pandemic situation, the number of Embarkation Points for haj 2021 have been reduced from existing 21 to 10. Calicut airport has not been designated as an Embarkation Point for Haj 2021. The arrangements for Haj 2021 are being made under special circumstances with special norms, rules & regulations, eligibility criteria, etc. due to Covid-19 Pandemic. Provisional guidelines including Embarkation Points for Haj 2021, have been issued by Haj Committee of India after extensive consultation with concerned Ministries and Indian mission in Saudi Arabia, taking into consideration the expected reduced Haj quota for Indian pilgrims to be allocated by the Saudi Government.
- (c): No Sir. Ministry of Minority Affairs decides the embarkation points on the recommendation of Haj Committee of India (HCoI).
