Environmental Clearance for Oil/Gas Exploration Project

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the production of crude oil and natural gas in India has been going down and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Government has decided to waive off environmental clearance for onshore and offshore gas as well as oil exploration projects and if so, the facts in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government has assessed its consequences on Islands, fishing areas, breeding grounds and migratory routes, etc. and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to minimize the consequences of onshore and offshore gas as well as oil exploration projects?

(a): Production of crude oil and Natural Gas in India for the last six years is as under:

Year	2014-15	2015-16	2016-17	2017-18	2018-19	2019-20
Crude Oil (MMT)	37.46	36.94	36.01	35.68	34.20	32.17
Natural Gas (BCM)	33.65	32.25	31.90	32.65	32.87	31.18

Natural Decline in all aging fields and increase in water-cut in major oil/gas producing fields are the main reasons for decline in oil/gas production.

(b) to (d): MoEF&CC vide gazette Notification dated 16th January, 2020 has changed the category for onshore and offshore oil and gas exploration projects from A to B2 under EIA Notification, 2006 wherein the permissions related to Environment shall be accorded by the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority. Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has not waived off clearance for onshore and offshore gas and oil projects. Environmental concerns/safeguards are addressed while issuing the environment clearance.
