SHUT DOWN OF AUTOMOBILE MANUFACTURING COMPANIES

1209. SHRI VINCENT H. PALA:

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES भारी उद्योग एवं लोक उद्यम मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details and the number of foreign automobile manufacturing companies that have left India or reduced operations during the last five years;
- (b) whether the Government is aware of reports that this is due to red tapism and high taxes;
- (c) if so, whether the Government plans to address these issues; and
- (d) the number of car manufacturing units and plants that have been shut down during the said period and their distribution, State-wise?

(a): As per information received from Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM), the following automobile companies have closed down their operations during last five years:-

- i) MAN Trucks
- ii) General motors
- iii) Harley Davidson
- iv) UM Motorcycles
- v) Honda cars (the company has stopped its production in Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh and made Tapukara plant in Rajasthan a unified manufacturing base)

(b): No such thing has been reported

(c): Does not arise in view of (b)

(d): The state-wise details of car manufacturing units and plants that have been shut down during the said period are as below:

- i) General Motors- Maharashtra
- ii) Honda Cars- Uttar Pradesh
