- (a) the number of small farmers benefited under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY);
- (b) the number of such farmers especially in Uttar Pradesh, district-wise; and
- (c) the details of total fund released under this scheme during the last three years?

(a) to (c): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India with highest ever estimate investment of Rs.20050 crores in fisheries sector for a period of 5 years with effect from the financial year 2020-21. During the current financial year (2020-21), the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has accorded approval to the proposals of 33 State Governments /Union Territories (UTs) including the proposal of Government of Uttar Pradesh for the benefit of about 2.87 lakh beneficiaries during the current financial year(2020-21) under the PMMSY. The district-wise details of the number of farmers benefitted under the PMMSY during the current financial year (2020-21) in Uttar Pradesh as reported by the Government of Uttar Pradesh are furnished at Annexure-I. As the PMMSY has been implemented with effect from the current financial year(2020-21), release of funds under this scheme during the last three years does not arise.
