Plastic Parks

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish Plastic Parks in the country and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has taken adequate steps for early establishment of Plastic Park at Deoghar District, Jharkhand;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which this plastic park likely to become operational;
- (d) whether the Government has made any assessment with regard to employment likely to be generated; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CHEMICALS & FERTILIZERS (SHRI D. V. SADANANDA GOWDA)

(a) Yes, Sir. The Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals has been implementing the Scheme for setting up of Plastic Parks. Currently, seven Plastic parks are under implementation. The details of the status of these Plastic parks (state-wise) are as under:

1. **Madhya Pradesh**: The Plastic park at **Tamot** has completed physical infrastructure and purchase of equipment for common facility centers (CFC) is in progress. One unit is functional in the Plastic Park.

2. **Madhya Pradesh**: The Plastic park at **Bilaua** is at various stages of implementation and work related to development of physical infrastructure is in progress.
3. **Odisha**: The Plastic park at **Paradeep** is at various stage of implementation and work related to development of physical infrastructure is almost completed.
4. **Jharkhand**: The work at Plastic park at **Deoghar** has started in August, 2019 and currently the work related to development of physical infrastructure is in progress.
5. **Tamil Nadu**: The work related to development of physical infrastructure at Plastic park at **Thiruvallur** is in progress.
6. **Assam**: The Plastic park at Tinsukia is in various stages of implementation and work related to development of physical infrastructure is in progress.
7. **Uttarakhand**: The Plastic park at **Sitarganj** has been approved recently and the various post approval formalities as per the Scheme guidelines are in progress.

(b) & (c) Yes, Sir. The Plastic park at Deoghar, Jharkhand was approved on 20.12.2018 by the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals and as per the signed agreement it is to be completed by the SPV Jharkhand Industrial Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (JIIDCO), Ranchi within three years i.e. by December, 2021.

(d) & (e) Yes, Sir. As per assessment submitted by the State Govt. of Jharkhand, more than 100 units are proposed to be set up in the park and, once fully functional, it is expected to generate about 9250 direct and indirect employment opportunities.
