**INCREASING THE STAFF STRENGTH OF CISF AT CALICUT AIRPORT**

**(a) whether the Government has taken note of the increasing number of passengers at Calicut Airport and the resultant workload of CISF; and**

**(b) if so, whether the Government has any plan to increase the staff strength of CISF at Calicut Airport as it has already crossed three million pax per annum?**

**(a) & (b): There was incremental growth in passenger movement at Calicut Airport till 2019. However, there has been significantly reduced operation of flights at the Airport due to Covid-19 pandemic. At present, there is no proposal under consideration to increase the staff strength of CISF at Calicut Airport.**
