(a) the number of coal based industries that have been shut down due to lack of coal in Raigarh district of Chattisgarh;

(b) the revenue loss being incurred due to shut down of industries;

(c) whether there is any plan to re-start these industrial units; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): Coal supply is regularly made by Mahanadi Coalfields Limited (MCL) to 9 and by South Eastern Coalfields Limited (SECL) to 41 Coal based industries at Raigarh district through Fuel Supply Agreement (FSA). MCL and SECL do not have any report of any of these industries which have FSA with these coal companies closing down due to shortage of coal.
