(a) & (b): The Selection Committee Meeting for the year 2019, for preparing the Select List for Appointment by Selection from non-State Civil Services to the Indian Administrative Services for the year 2019, had been convened by Union Public Service Commission on 30th and 31st December, 2020 based on the inputs from the State Government of Rajasthan. The recommendations of the Selection Committee are yet to be received by the Central Government from the State Government.

Complaints/objections that were received regarding the recommendations sent by the Rajasthan Government for promoting the officers working in cadres other than Rajasthan Administrative Services to Indian Administrative Service have been forwarded for appropriate action to the State Government of Rajasthan, as it is the sole custodian of service records of the concerned Officers.
