SHIFTING PRODUCTION FROM CHINA TO INDIA

Will the Minister of **COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY** be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of multinational companies of United States and other foreign countries which shifted their base from China to India during the last one year;
- (b) the details of the foreign investment received so far in the country, State-wise;
- (c) the details and the number of new employment generated /likely to be generated from such multinational companies in the country; and
- (d) the details of the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for bringing in more manufacturing industries in the country to boost economy?

(SHRI SOM PARKASH)**

- (a): 4 companies in the Electronic System Design Manufacturing (ESDM) sector have diversified their manufacturing base from China to India. However, there are several companies who have indicated their plan/interest to relocate.
- (b): Details of state-wise FDI Equity inflow reported during October, 2019 till November, 2020 are at **Annexure A**.
- (c): Employment for 31,509 people is likely to be generated from the relocation projects at present.
- (d): The Government has set up a high level Empowered Group of Secretaries chaired by the Cabinet Secretary, and a Project Development Cell (PDC) in ministries/ departments with a view to provide support and facilitation to investors for investing in India. Several steps like Production Linked Incentive Scheme, GIS mapping of available land banks, issuance of Quality Control Order to cut down cheap imports have been put into place to attract further investment into the country.
