SETTING UP OF COLD STORAGE

147. SHRIMATI SARMISTHA SETHI:

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any proposal to set up more cold storage facilities in the country;
- (b) If so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (c) the details regarding total number of functional and dysfunctional cold stores in the country and also the stores that can be revived States/UT-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) & (b): The Government does not setup cold storage of its own. However, the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare (**DoAC&FW**) is implementing Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (**MIDH**) for development of Horticulture in the country. Under MIDH, assistance is provided for development of Post Harvest Management (**PHM**) including establishment of cold storages.

The components of PHM are demand/entrepreneur-driven from among entrepreneurs, private companies, cooperatives, farmers group etc. through commercial ventures for which assistance @35% of admissible project cost in general areas and 50% in hilly and scheduled area is available as credit linked back ended subsidy through respective State Horticulture Missions.

(c): As per available information, the State-wise details of cold storage sanctioned since 2014 under MIDH is given in **Annexure**.

However, no separate data regarding functional and dysfunctional cold stores in the country is maintained in the Department.
