- (a) the data of development projects which were under construction before the outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic;
- (b) whether there has been any progress in these projects since the nationwide lockdown due to COVID-19 pandemic;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation compiles data on time and cost overruns of on-going Central Sector Infrastructure Projects costing Rs. 150 crore and above, on the basis of information provided by the project implementing agencies on the On-line Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS). As on 01.04.2020, a total of 1686 Central Sector Infrastructure Projects costing Rs. 150 crore and above were on the monitor of this Ministry.
- (b) Yes Sir.

- (c) Total expenditure incurred on the on-going Central Sector Infrastructure Projects during the financial year 2020-21 (upto December 2020) was Rs 1,17,148.08 crore. Also during the current financial year, 61 projects have reported completion.
