Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that like previous years this year also trains are running late/cancelled due to fog and if so, the details thereof, Zone-wise;

(b) whether the uavailability of path is (Platform/ lines) also one of the reasons for delay in trains, if so, the details thereof and the action taken by the Government in this regard so far;

(c) whether there is any shortage of washing pit lines and stabling lines and if so, the details thereof Zone-wise; and

(d) the number of new washing pit lines that have been established in the last five years, zone-wise?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Operations of trains get affected by fog. The Zone-wise details of trains which ran late and that which have been cancelled during the period December, 2020 to January, 2021, due to fog is as under:

To assist the Loco Pilots run the train during foggy weather condition, Fog PASS Device, a Global Positioning System (GPS) based hand held portable device, is given to Loco Pilots in fog affected sections. It serves as an aid for the crew during foggy weather through audio visual alarm, wherever any landmark comes within the Geo-fence range. Location of stations, warning boards, signals, level crossing gates and Whistle for Level crossing (W/L) boards in the section is fed in the equipment. It displays speed of the locomotive, distance and time to reach landmarks and is an important aid to Loco Pilots. In addition to fog, other factors also impact punctual running of trains which include capacity constraints including path constraints on saturated routes, asset failures, alarm chain pulling, agitations, cattle run over, bad weather and other unforeseen circumstances. Based on assessments of factors impeding the punctual running of trains, remedial measures, both short term and long term, are initiated. High priority is accorded to making resources available for speedy execution of critical capacity augmentation as these on completion *inter-alia* facilitate improved efficiency and reliability in train operations.

(c) Adequate numbers of stabling lines and washing lines (Pit lines) are available for existing maintenance requirement over Zonal Railways.

(d) The number of new washing pit lines that have been established in the last five years, zone-wise are as under:-
