162. MS. MIMI CHAKRABORTY:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
मात्स्यिकी, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री  
be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned funds under Rashtriya Gokul Mission for setting up of 21 gokul grams as integrated cattle development centres in the country;
- (b) if so, the present status of the project and the productivity therein; and
- (c) the present status support of 'Pashu Sanjivani-an animal health card' in the country thereof?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING  
(DR. SANJEEV KUMAR BALYAN)**

(a) &(b) Yes, Sir. Setting up of 21 Gokul Grams have been sanctioned under Rashtriya Gokul Mission and out of this funds have been released to the States for establishment of 16 Gokul Grams. Present status of the Gokul Grams along with productivity therein is given at **Annexure-I**.

(c) States and Union Territories have been supported under Pashu Sanjivni component of Rashtriya Gokul Mission for identification and issuing Nakul Swasthya Patra (animal health cards) to animals in milk. Component Pashu Sanjivni has been discontinued since inception of National Animal Disease Control Programme in 2019. Under National Animal Disease Control Programme identification of animals is extended to all bovine animals as well as sheep, goat and pigs numbering total 53.5 crore. So far 13.62 crore animals have been identified and their data on breeding and health has been uploaded on Information Network for Animal Productivity and Health.
