Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the target set for building the houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) by the year 2022;**
- (b) the details of such targets achieved and yet to be achieved, State-wise;**
- (c) the quantum of funds allocated for PMAY-U; and**
- (d) whether the Government proposes to increase the allocation of funds under PMAY-U and if so, the details thereof?**

(a) & (b) Under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban [PMAY-U], States/UTs have undertaken a demand survey and reported validated demand of around 112.2 lakh houses in urban areas. So far, 109,88,765 houses have been sanctioned, State/UT wise details of which are at Annexure.

(c) & (d) Sanctioned houses under PMAY – U involves Central Assistance of Rs. 1,77,409.3 crore of which Rs. 84,606.7 crore have already been released. Government is committed to provide approved Central Assistance to fund the sanctioned houses under PMAY-U.
