- (a) the details of the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to improve, strengthen and ensure availability of drinking water in rural area of the country in the next five years; and
- (b) the details of the rural areas identified to implement the scheme, State-wise?

(a) & (b) Since August, 2019 to enable every rural household in the country to have assured potable water supply by 2024, Government of India, in partnership with States is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal with an estimated outlay of Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore. Based on the requirement, under JJM, States/ UTs are vested with powers to plan, approve and implement water supply schemes in rural areas.
