LOANS UNDER PMEGP

1650. SHRI ANURAG SHARMA:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether loans are being disbursed for youths under Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) in various States including Uttar Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof during the last two years, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the details of loan provided to youths of Uttar Pradesh under the said scheme during the said period including the target set in this regard, district-wise;
- (d) the steps taken up by the Government to achieve the above said target; and
- (e) whether the Government has made any assessment regarding the achievements made under PMEGP and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NITIN GADKARI)

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir. Under this scheme, loan is being provided by banks and the Margin Money (MM) subsidy is being disbursed by Ministry of MSME through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC). The State/UT-wise detail of loan released is given at **Annexure -I.**
- (c): Under PMEGP scheme, district-wise targets for Margin Money (MM) subsidy are fixed, which are indicative in nature. Loans are disbursed by the banks as per suitability of the projects and MM subsidy is released on them accordingly. District-wise target and achievement of Margin Money subsidy under PMEGP in Uttar Pradesh during the last two years is given at **Annexure-II**.
- (d): The following steps have been taken by the Government to achieve the target:
 - (i) The process of application flow, including bank sanctions and disbursement, has been made faster and transparent through introduction of on-line portal.
 - (ii) The process of selection of entrepreneurs has been further streamlined with the discontinuation of the role of District Level Task Force Committee (DLTFC) since April, 2020, in recommending proposals/applications to financing banks. In the revised scenario, the proposals are now sent directly by Implementing Agencies to financing banks based on a Score Card model approved by Indian Bankers' Association, thereby reducing the overall approval period.

- (iii) Organizing of Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP), mandatory before disbursal of loan by Banks, has been made online since October 2019 to provide expedited training and release of loan to the beneficiaries.
- (iv) Free two day online pre- EDP training has been introduced for interested applicants.
- (v) The list of activities has been expanded to attract entrepreneurs for setting up diverse
- (vi) Implementing Agencies like KVIC, State Khadi and Village Industries Board (KVIB) and District Industries Centres (DICs) are providing handholding to applicants, through call centres, online tutorials as well as with help desks with banking and marketing experts.
- (vii) Sector/industry wise webinars are also being organized every Sunday involving industry experts and banks with participation of more than 300,000 prospective applicants.
- (viii) Regular meetings are held by the Ministry and KVIC with Banks through Department of Financial Services.
- (ix) Champions.gov.in, a unified, empowered, robust and technology driven web based platform with 68 control rooms, have been launched by the Ministry in June, 2020, to promptly redress the grievances of MSMEs and other related stakeholders at the field level
- (e): Government has assessed the achievements under PMEGP through information available on PMEGP e-portal, physical verification of actual establishments conducted between 24 to 36 months after their setting up and independent third party evaluation of the scheme conducted from time to time.

The details of the achievement are as follows:

- i. Since inception till 31.01.2021, 5.53 lakh units have been assisted utilizing MM subsidy of Rs. 15308.23 cr. generating approximately 53.8 lakh employment.
- ii. 80% of the micro units are in the rural area with around 15% units in Aspirational districts
- iii. More than 50% of the micro units are set up by the SC/ST/Women entrepreneurs.
- iv. The scheme has been able to generate 5-6 lakh sustainable employment per year.
- v. The scheme is presently generating average employment of 7 persons per project
- vi. Average Cost of the project is Rs 10.13 lakh
- vii. Average cost of generating unit employment is around Rs. 1.5 lakh
