Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government is considering a National Bus Rejuvenation Programme to boost bus based public transport for cities across the country;
- b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the programme will be launched; and
- c) Whether the States have been or shall be consulted in the framing of the Programme and if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. Government is considering to launch a new Scheme, in consultation with all stakeholders including States, to augment bus based public transport in 111 cities through procurement of over 20,000 city buses for 5 lakh plus population cities, including Hilly/ UT/ North East State capital cities with an estimated outlay of Rs.18,000 crores. Due process for approval has commenced.
