- (a): State/U.T. wise number of grievances received on 'CHAMPIONS' portal and action taken thereon; is given at Annexure-I.
- (b) & (c): Post Covid-19, Government has taken a number of initiatives under Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan to support the MSME sector in the country especially in Covid 19 pandemic. Some of them are:
 - i) Rs. 3 Lakh crore Collateral Free Automatic Loans for business, including MSMEs.
 - ii) Rs.20,000 crore Subordinate Debt for Stressed MSMEs.
 - iii) Rs. 50,000 crore equity infusion through MSME Fund of Funds.
 - iv) New Revised criteria for classification of MSMEs.
 - v) New Registration of MSMEs through 'Udyam Registration' for Ease of Doing Business.
 - vi) No global tenders for procurement up to Rs. 200 crores, this will help MSME.
