IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON HOUSING FOR ALL

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the scheme of the Government to provide houses to all by 2022 has been affected due to COVID-19;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of cities in the country where work is going on under this scheme;
- (d) the status of the ongoing construction of houses in Maharashtra; and
- (e) the details of the under construction houses in Mumbai, Pune, Nanded and Aurangabad?

ANSWER

(a)&(b) Due to COVID-19, there has been some delay in construction of houses under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U). The progress of construction has picked up very soon. The Union and State/ Union Territory (UT) Governments have strategized to accelerate the pace of construction and complete the projects within the stipulated timeframe.

(c) At present under the PMAY-U the work is going on in 4,459 cities throughout the country.

(d)&(e)The details of ongoing /under construction of houses under PMAY-U in Maharashtra, including Mumbai, Pune, Nanded and Aurangabad are as under:
