- (a) whether the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has lost huge amount of money due to farmers' protest in the country;

- (c) the corrective steps taken by the Government to generate more revenues and to expedite the ongoing and future highway projects in the country?

(a) to (c) Due to farmers protest, some of the fee plazas are nonoperational, thereby NHAI is unable to collect user fee from the road users. In case of public funded fee plazas, an estimated remittance loss is approximately 1.8 cr per day.
