**Piped Drinking Water to Villages**

+1753: SHRIMATI REKHA VERMA:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of villages in Uttar Pradesh having piped drinking water facility;
- (b) the number of villages covered/ to be covered under such scheme during the current financial year to get piped drinking water; and
- (c) the time by which all the villages are likely to be covered there under?

**ANSWER

- (a) As on 08.02.2021, out of 97,494 villages in the State of Uttar Pradesh, 17,781 villages are reported to have piped drinking water supply.
- (b) As reported, every household in 2,011 villages in Uttar Pradesh are getting tap water supply and 12,920 villages are planned to be provided with piped water supply during 2020-21.
- (c) As reported, all villages in Uttar Pradesh are likely to be provided with tap water supply by 2024.
