(a) to (e): The Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports undertakes various Youth Centric activities all over the country, including State of Andhra Pradesh through its organizations viz. (i) National Service Scheme (NSS) (ii) Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) & (iii) Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD). The details are at Annexure-I:

Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS):

The aim of Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) Organization under Department of Youth Affairs is to develop the personality and leadership qualities of Youth and also to engage them in nation building activities. NYKS undertakes following set of programmes including Andhra Pradesh for youth club development:

1. Youth Club Development Programme
2. Training on Youth Leadership and Community Development
3. Promotion of Sports
 - a. Block level Sports Meet
 - b. District level Sports Meet
4. Skill Up-gradation Training Programme
5. Promotion of Folk, Art and Culture
6. Observance of Days of National and International Importance
7. District Youth Convention
8. Mahatma Gandhi Swachhta Abhiyan Avam Sharamdaan Karyakram
9. Yuva Aadarsh Gram Vikas Karyakaram
10. Awards to Outstanding Youth Club at District, State and National levels.

National Service Scheme (NSS):

National Service Scheme (NSS) of Department of Youth Affairs is introduced with running primary objective of developing the personality and character development of student youth through voluntary service to the community. NSS is implemented in 33 Universities covering 1,518 Colleges/Institutions in all the 13 districts of Andhra Pradesh. There are 2,04,100 student Volunteers enrolled under NSS and involving themselves in the various community development activities such as Special Camping programme in the adopted villages/slums, regular activities in and around their college campus. In order to encourage and promote the youth activities, the Union Government is providing opportunities to the NSS Volunteers to participate in the National Integration Camps, District/State/National Youth Parliament, National Youth Festivals, Pre-Republic Day Parade Camp and NSS Republic Day Parade Camp, Swachh Bharat Campaigns etc.

Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development (RGNIYD): The Institute functions as a think tank of the Ministry and premier organization of Youth relate activities in the country.

The following programmes were organized by RGNIYD at Andhra Pradesh in 2019 - 2020:

Year: 2019

- Tribal Youth Exchange Programme (Under TSP-Scheduled Tribe) 04 January 2019.
- One Day Orientation Programme for the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports (Government of India). The programme was attended by 220 Tribal Youth from Andhra Pradesh, Chhattisgarh & Jharkhand. Training on ten core life

skills *Viz.* Self Awareness, Creative Thinking, Critical Thinking, Decision Making, Problem Solving, Empathy, Communication skills, Time management, Interpersonal skills, Leadership, Positive attitude, Coping with emotions and Coping with stress and stress management and Creating Self-Reliant Communities were imparted to the participants.

- Training of Trainers on Employability Skills for NSS Programme Officers was conducted from 10- 12 July 2019 at Yogi Vemana University, Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh for NSS Programme Officers.
- Training of Trainers on Social Entrepreneurship was conducted from 22-24 August 2019 at Adikavi Nannayya University, SC and ST College Teachers Rajamahendravaram, Andhra Pradesh.
- Entrepreneurship Education Tour was conducted from 30 October -05 November 2019 at Hyderabad for Students of MA Social Innovation and Entrepreneurship

Year: 2020

- Enhancing Skills of Youth of North East India through Rural Technologies Skill Training on Preparation on Herbal Beauty Care Products for the Youth from 18-22 February 2020 at National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Hyderabad for The unemployed youth of the north east from Mizoram.
- Skill Training on Preparation on Preparation of Soya & Millet Product and Solar Lights Assembling Installation and Maintenance for the Youth from Nagaland conducted from 22-26 February 2020 at National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Hyderabad.
- Skill Training on Conversion of Handmade Paper into Value - added Products and Natural Dyeing for the Youth from Mizoram conducted from 07-13 March 2020 at National Institute of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj, Hyderabad for unemployed youth of the north east – Mizoram.

The grant sanctioned to Andhra Pradesh for NSS Activities in the last 2 years was Rs.77389084/- for the year 2018-19 and Rs.96924775/- for the year 2019-20.
