NO. 1766. SHRI GANESH SINGH:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether poverty alleviation, affordable housing and sanitation are being addressed through programmes of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY-NULM), Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-Housing for All) and Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM);
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of beneficiaries of district Satna since inception of the said schemes; and
- (c) whether the basic infrastructure are being focused upon through the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) and if so, the details thereof along with number of beneficiaries of district Satna?

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Sir
- (b) Details are given in the Annexure-I.

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(c) Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is implementing Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation(AMRUT) in selected 500 cities across the country to provide urban infrastructure for water supply, sewerage, septage management, storm water drainage, non-motorised transport, green spaces and parks. It is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme with a Central outlay of ₹50,000 crore. Against the plan size of ₹77,640 crore, which includes Central Assistance of ₹36,036 crore, ₹39,011 crore (50%) has been allocated to water supply, ₹32,456 crore (42%) to sewerage & septage projects, ₹2,969 crore (4%) towards drainage projects, ₹1,436 crore (2%) for non-motorised urban transport and ₹1,768 crore (2%) has been allocated for green spaces and parks.Details of the Mission and the beneficiaries in Satna are given in Annexure-II.

Annexure-I referred to in reply to Part (b) of Lok Sabha Unstarred Question No 1766 regarding 'Affordable Housing'

(i) <u>Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods</u>
<u>Mission(DAY-NULM)</u>

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is implementing DAY-NULM with the objective of reducing the poverty and vulnerability of urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities for improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis. The Mission also aims at providing shelter for urban homeless and addressing livelihood concerns of urban street vendors. The details of the beneficiaries in Urban Local Bodies(ULBs) in Satna district are given below:

Employment through skill training and placement

Trained and certified candidates:2,334 Candidates placed: 1,381

Social Mobilization and Institutional Development

Self Help Groups(SHGs) formed: 5,700 SHGs given Revolving Fund:4,260 SHG Bank Linkage done: 1,620

Self-Employment Program

Support to Urban Street Vendors

Beneficiaries provides Vending Identy card and Vending Certificate:14,202

(ii) Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban(PMAY-U)

Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is implementing PMAY-U with the objective of providing assistance to States/Union Territories for meeting housing shortage for people belonging to Economically Weaker Sections(EWS), Low Income Group(LIG) and Middle Income Group(MIG) in urban areas. The aim of the Mission is to provide housing for all by the year 2022. In ULBs in Satna district a total of 20,438 houses have been sanctioned. Out of this, 18,037 are at various stages of construction and 11,055 have been completed/delivered. Central Assistance of ₹307.58 crore has been sanctioned of which ₹203.94 crore has been released.

(iii) Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban(SBM-U)

Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) is being implemented in all statutory towns in the country with the following two primary objective of achieving:

- a. 100% open defecation free (ODF) status, and
- b. 100% solid waste management

Individual Household Latrines have been provided to 21,735 beneficiaries in ULBs in district Satna under this Mission.

Annexure-II referred to in reply to Part (c) of Lok Sabha Unstarred Question No 1766 regarding 'Affordable Housing'

Details of progress under AMRUT mission and beneficiaries in Satna are mentioned below:-

In Satna, 5 projects worth ₹261 crore (one each in water supply, sewerage & septage, drainage, non-motorised urban transport and green spaces and parks) have been taken up of which 3 projects worth ₹61 crore have been completed and 2 projects worth ₹200 crore are in progress. The detailed status of projects is as under:
