UPGRADATION OF NHs

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) whether the Government has any proposal to undertake upgradation of various National Highways(NHs) in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the total number of National Highways in the State of Tamil Nadu likely to be covered under this proposal along with financial implication involved; and

(d) the time by which the said upgradation of NHs in Tamil Nadu is likely to be completed?

(a) & (b) Yes, Ministry has proposed to undertake the upgradation of 44069 km National Highways in the next 3 years at an estimated cost of Rs. 8.32 lakh Crore under National Infrastructure Pipeline Projects (NIP) in the country.

(c) & (d) In the State of Tamil Nadu, Ministry has proposed to undertake the development of 2549 km National Highways in the next 3 years at an estimated cost of about Rs. 72,861 Crore.
