Domestic Tap Connections

† 1807. DR. VIRENDRA KUMAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has implemented/ proposes to implement Jal Jivan Mission (JJM) in partnership with the States which aim to provide ready to operate domestic tap connection to every family household in villages by 2024;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of the progress made under JJM in Madhya Pradesh, district-wise?

**ANSWER

(a) & (b) Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission – Har Ghar Jal in partnership with States, to enable every rural household to have potable water of prescribed quality, in adequate quantity, on long-term and regular basis through tap water connection by 2024. The total estimated outlay of Jal Jeevan Mission is Rs. 3.60 lakh Crore.

(c) Jan Jeevan Mission was announced on 15th August, 2019. At the time of announcement, in Madhya Pradesh, out of 123.05 lakh rural households, 13.53 lakh (11%) households were reported to have tap water connections. Since then, 18.92 lakh households have been provided tap water connections. Thus, as of date, 32.45 lakh (26.37%) rural households in the State are having tap water supply in their homes.
